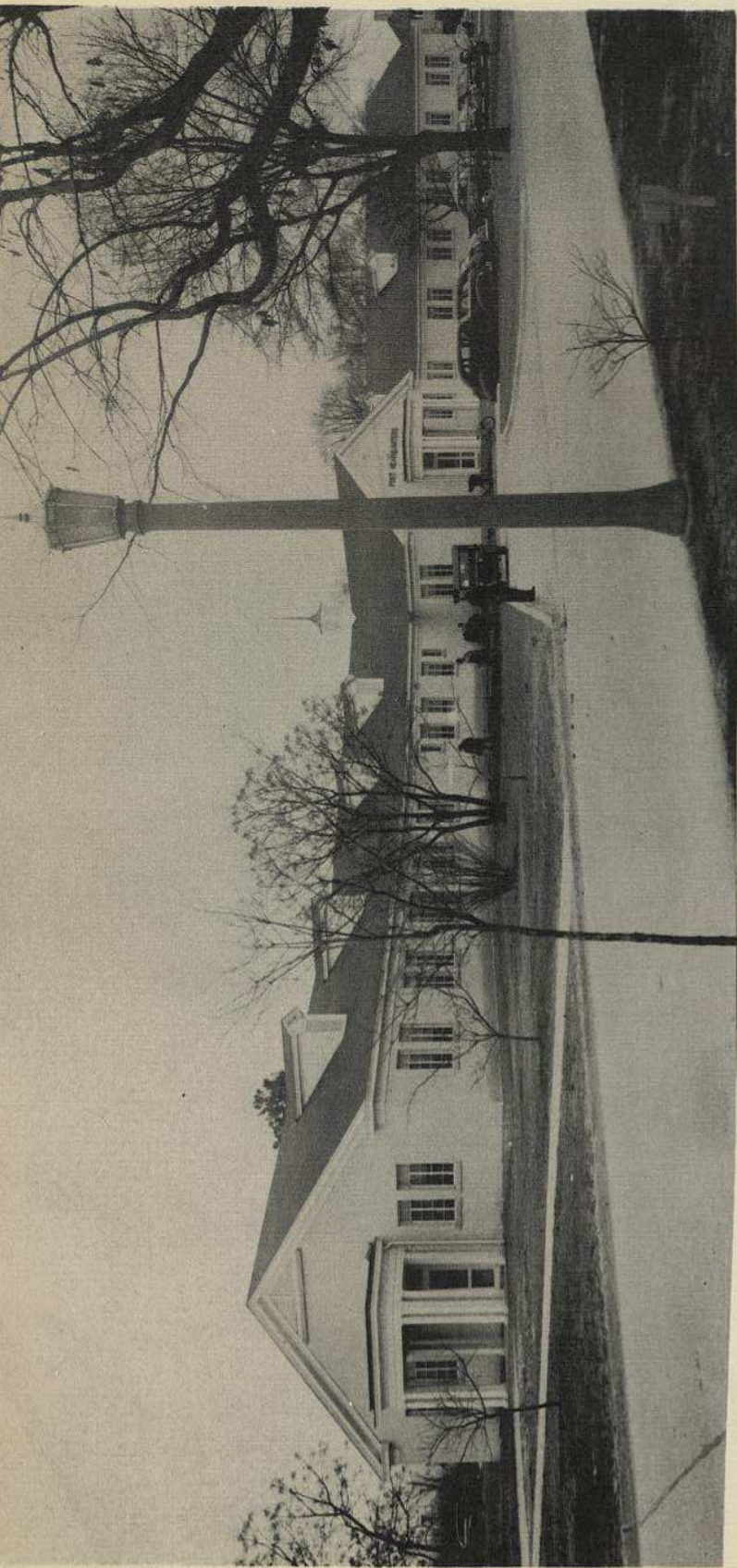

Maxwell Field, Montgomery, Ala., one of the oldest of the Air Corps' many flying fields, was so named in honor of Second Lieutenant Wilham C. Maxwell, an Alabamian, who met his death in an airplane accident while stationed in the Philippine Islands. The site of Maxwell Field was selected by Mr. Wilbur Wright for a flying school in 1910.

Major General George E. Stratemeyer, commanding the Southeast Air Corps Training Center, and his staff, have their Headquarters in Austin Hall. The Advanced Flying School, under command of Colonel Elmer J. Bowling, was established to give advanced training to Aviation Cadets who successfully complete the courses at primary and basic flying schools in the Southeast Air Corps Training Center.

Also located at Maxwell Field is the Air Corps Replacement Training Center (Air Crew), where cadets are first inducted into the Air Corps. Here they receive training in the school of the soldier and other ground school subjects before being classified for pilot, navigation or bombardier training, which they subsequently receive in schools throughout the Training Center.

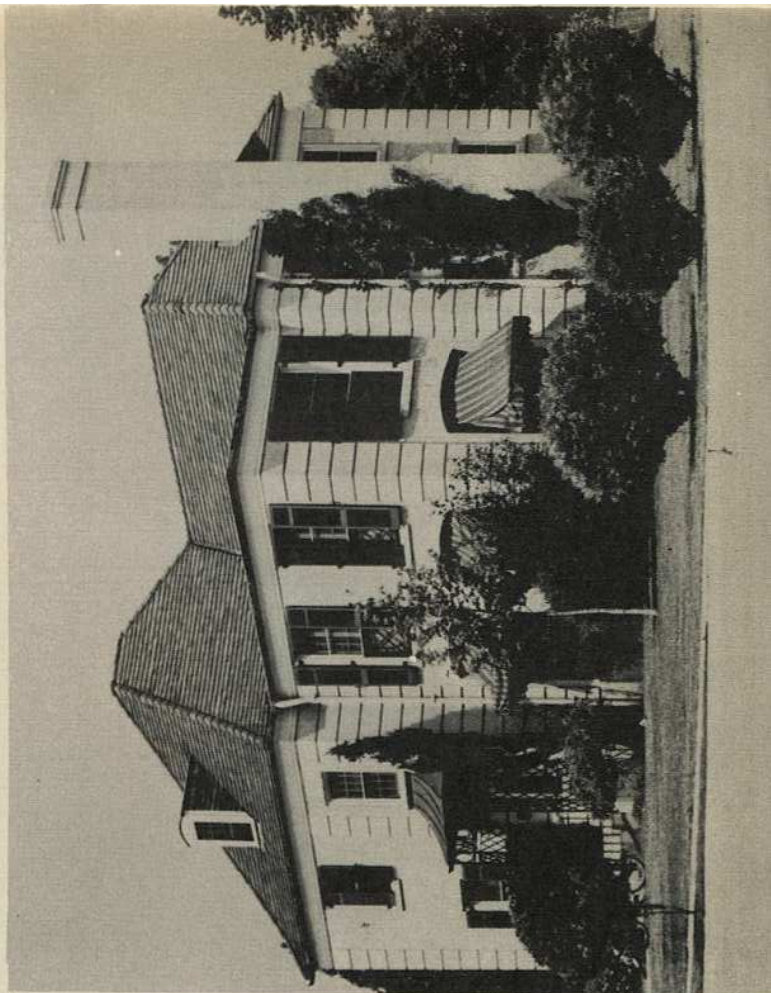


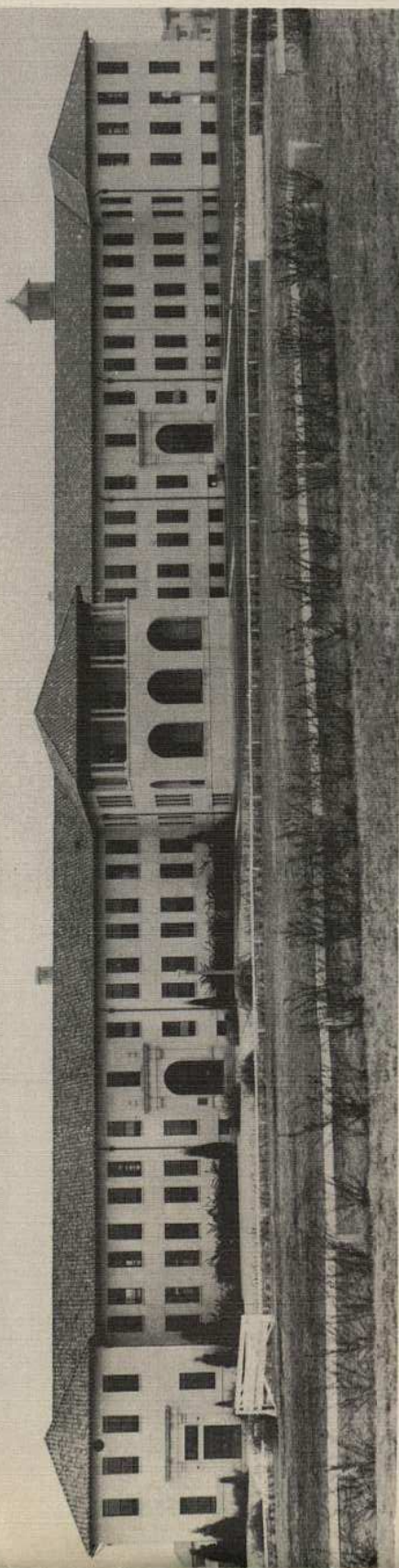
