When the war department discontinued lighter-than-aire activity, it was de cided to "re-make" Scott Field. The big morning most, hangar and helium plant was torn down and in 1938 a big building program was launched. In 1939 the radio communications school was moved to Scott from Chanete Field communications ochool was moved to score from channel it and the training of readiomen began.


