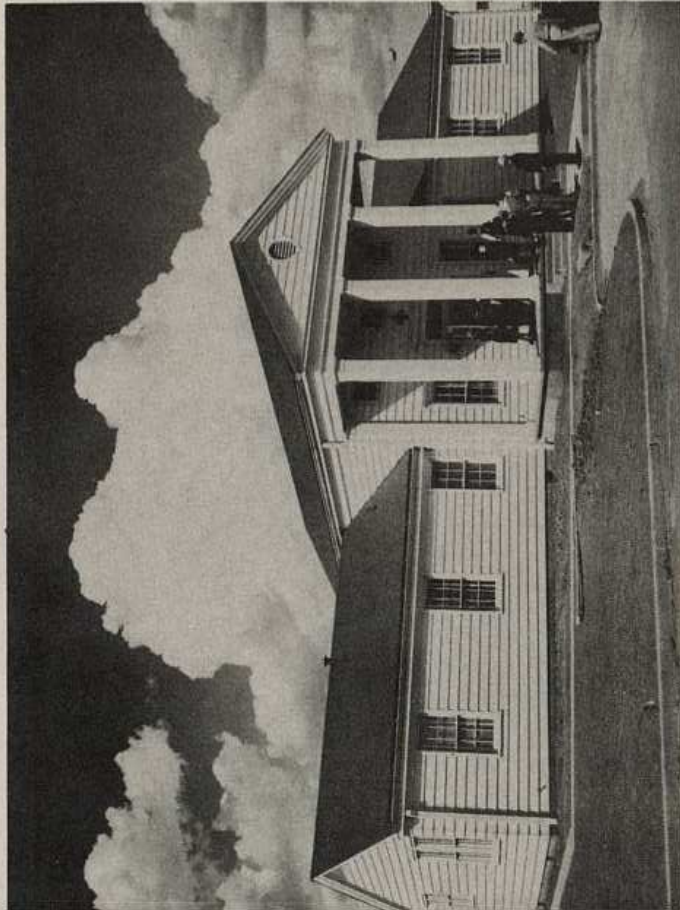
POST EXCHANGE
